Categories

Citizen of the Year

This is presented to someone making an extraordinary contribution to the community and may recognise outstanding service over a number of years.

To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen.

Young Citizen of the Year

This is presented to a young emerging leader who is making a difference in their community.

To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen aged over 16 years and under 30 years of age on January 26, 2023.

Senior Citizen of the Year

This is presented to a senior person who is making a real difference in their community, potentially over multiple years.

To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen aged 65 years or over on January 26, 2023.

Community Event of the Year

This is presented to the person or group who has staged the most outstanding event for their community.

To be eligible, the person or group must be Australian Citizens.

Award for Active Citizenship

This is presented to a person or group delivering outstanding work on an event or project for the community during the past calendar year.

The person or group need not be Australian Citizens.

Salisbury Community Achievement

This Award is for a person or group delivering outstanding work in the community during the past year.

Open to all Salisbury residents and ratepayer regardless of citizenship. The person or business need not be Australian Citizens.
