City of Salisbury recognises the importance of protecting the community from preventable diseases and is committed to ensuring residents have ongoing access to free immunisation services.

There are currently four clinic locations available and no appointment is required.

Immunisation Clinic

The City of Salisbury is dedicated to safeguarding the community against preventable diseases. We provide accessible and free immunisation services aligned with the National Immunisation Program Schedule and offer catch-up immunisations for secondary school students through approved Schools Immunisation Programs.

Our Services

Our free immunisation services are facilitated by Health & Immunisation Management Services across four convenient locations. Child and adolescent scheduled vaccines are available free to all Medicare card holders. No appointments are necessary.

What You Need to Bring

Ensure to bring the following:

- Medicare card
- Child's Health and Development Book (Blue Book)
- Any relevant immunisation records

If your child has received vaccinations overseas, please provide translated copies of the records before visiting the clinics.

If your child is under 16 and attending our clinic, parental/legal guardian consent is mandatory for vaccine administration. If you cannot accompany your child, you must be reachable by phone for verbal consent.

Immunisation Records

The quickest way to get your Immunisation statement is by using your Medicare online account through myGov or the Express Plus Medicare mobile app.
