

## Immunisation records

The quickest way to get your Immunisation statement is by using your Medicare online account through myGov or the Express Plus Medicare mobile app.

You can also call the AIR enquiries line on 1800 653 809.

It can take up to 14 days to receive your statement in the post.

## What you need to bring

Ensure to bring the following:

- Medicare card
- Child's Health and Development Book (Blue Book)
- Any relevant immunisation records

If your child has received vaccinations overseas, please provide translated copies of the records before visiting the clinics.

If your child is under 16 and attending our clinic, parental/legal guardian consent is mandatory for vaccine administration.

If you cannot accompany your child, you must be reachable by phone for verbal consent.
