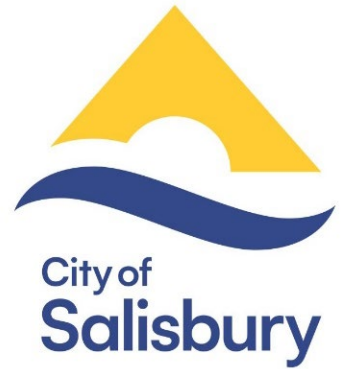

BACKGROUND SCREENING REQUIREMENT
