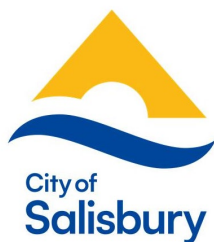

**1. BACKGROUND**

- 1.1 At its meeting held on Monday, 27 April 2021 Council resolved:

*“That a standing report be established for every meeting of the Tree Management Appeals Sub Committee to inform Council of every application received for tree removal and the outcome of that request.”*  
*Resolution 0916/2021*

- 1.2 Staff currently upload a removal request information table to the Elected Members Portal. This document has been adapted to provide further information and will now be reported to each Environmental Sustainability and Trees Sub Committee Meeting.

**2. EXTERNAL CONSULTATION / COMMUNICATION**

- 2.1 Various residents.

### 3. DISCUSSION

- 3.1 The attached tables summarise requests for tree removals received and actioned by staff during the past month and have been provided on the Elected Member Portal for October, November and December 2024.

#### October 2024

- 3.1.1 Eighty (80) tree removal requests were received in October 2024.
- 3.1.2 Of these requests, fifty-seven (57) were approved for removal of which twenty-four (24) were significant or regulated trees and approved through development applications and 33 were non-regulated or significant.
- 3.1.3 Twenty-three (23) requests were refused. Of these, twenty (20) are related to significant or regulated trees under the *Planning Development and Infrastructure Act 2016*.

#### November 2024

- 3.1.4 Fifty-nine (59) tree removal requests were received in November 2024.
- 3.1.5 Of these requests, forty-two (42) were approved for removal of which twenty-one (21) were significant or regulated trees and approved through development applications.
- 3.1.6 Seventeen (17) requests were refused. Of these, sixteen (16) are related to significant or regulated trees under the *Planning Development and Infrastructure Act 2016*.

#### December 2024

- 3.1.7 Eighty-three (83) tree removal requests were received in December 2024.
- 3.1.8 Of these requests, sixty-seven (67) were approved for removal of which thirty-five (35) were significant or regulated trees and approved through development applications.
- 3.1.9 Sixteen (16) requests were refused. Of these, all thirteen (13) are related to significant or regulated trees under the *Planning Development and Infrastructure Act 2016*.
- 3.2 Tree removal requests often result in ongoing dialogue between the owner of the property and Council on the proposed tree removal and subsequent discussions around the species type and location of the new street tree.
- 3.3 It is important to note that through various annual programs Council plants 2,000 trees each year. These programs include the Street Tree Renewal Program, In-fill Planting Program, Tree Screen Renewal Program, Reserve Upgrade Program, Feature Landscape Renewal Program, Greening Program, School Tree Planting Program, Major Projects and ad-hoc planting requests. These tree renewal programs are cognisant of regulated, significant trees or those forming habitat corridors.

**4. FINANCIAL OVERVIEW**

- 4.1 The budget allocation for reactive tree removals for 2024/25 is \$394,200.
- 4.2 As of 31 December 2024, the total spend was \$200,830.00 with \$193,370.00 allocated budget remaining.




<b>SUMMARY</b>	In line with the approved tree removal procedure several decisions relating to the retention of trees have been appealed.

**RECOMMENDATION**

That Council:

1. Notes that the technical tree assessments undertaken for the following locations do not conclude removal be recommended, based solely on the application of Council approved tree removal criteria:
  - a. 12 Hawthorn Terrace Parafield Gardens
  - b. 1 Metala Road Paralowie
  - c. 10 Morgan Street Parafield Gardens
2. Notes that, as part of the appeal process, the refused tree removal requests appealed during October, November and December 2024, as outlined in the report (Item ESATS3 Environmental Sustainability and Trees Sub Committee 10 February 2025), are now presented to the Environmental Sustainability and Trees Sub Committee for consideration and/or recommendation to Council as per the Environmental Sustainability and Trees Sub Committee’s Terms of Reference.

That the Environmental Sustainability and Trees Sub Committee, using its delegated authority under its adopted Terms of Reference:

3. Refuses the removal of the one (1) *Regulated* tree located at 12 Hawthorn Terrace, Parafield Gardens.
4. Refuses the removal of the one (1) Significant tree located at 1 Metala Road, Paralowie.
5. Refuses the removal of the one (1) Significant tree located at 10 Morgan Street, Parafield Gardens.

### 1. BACKGROUND

1.1 In line with the approved tree removal procedure, residents are able to appeal decisions relating to the retention of trees. This appeal process involves:

- Report to the Environmental Sustainability and Trees Sub Committee (ESATS).
- Notification of outcome to residents.

### 2. EXTERNAL CONSULTATION / COMMUNICATION

2.1 Residents.

2.2 Ward Councillors in line with the adopted procedures.

### 3. DISCUSSION

3.1 Significant and regulated trees are offered protection through the *Planning Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* (the PDI Act) and require development applications for removal. Objectives for assessment of development applications are contained within the Regulated and Significant Tree Overlay of the PDI Act:

*Regulated trees are retained where they:*

- *make an important visual contribution to local character and amenity;*
- *are indigenous to the local area and listed under the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972 as a rare or endangered native species; and/or*
- *provide an important habitat for native fauna.*

*Significant trees are retained where they:*

- *make an important contribution to the character or amenity of the local area;*
- *are indigenous to the local area and are listed under the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972 as a rare or endangered native species;*
- *represent an important habitat for native fauna;*
- *are part of a wildlife corridor of a remnant area of native vegetation;*
- *are important to the maintenance of biodiversity in the local environment; and/or*
- *form a notable visual element to the landscape of the local area.*

3.2 These objectives are distinct from City of Salisbury criteria for removal, which are not a consideration through the development assessment.

3.3 The following appeal has been lodged under the Tree Removal Procedure and the resident is seeking removal of the tree.

3.4 The initial assessment for this appeal has identified that the tree is healthy, in good condition without any structural flaws and didn't meet City of Salisbury criteria for removal.

3.5 Where appropriate, pruning or canopy reduction has been undertaken to help alleviate concerns raised and actively manage the trees.

3.6 Following notification of appeal from the resident, and where appropriate, site meetings were arranged given the history with the trees.

3.7 Any further information provided by residents was reviewed and the appeals are presented directly to the Environmental Sustainability and Trees Sub Committee for recommendation to Council for consideration.

3.8 **12 Hawthorn Terrace, Parafield Gardens (regulated tree)**

3.8.1 The Euc citriodora tree is noted as regulated under the amended PDI Act in May 2024 and has been inspected by two independent arborists.

3.8.2 Preliminary Planning Advice for a Regulated Tree was sought and a Development Application is not likely to be supported.

3.8.3 The tree is in good health and doesn't achieve removal through the current criteria framework.



**3.9 1 Metala Road, Paralowie (significant tree)**

- 3.9.1 The Euc sideroxylon tree is noted as significant under the amended PDI Act in May 2024 and has been inspected by two independent arborists.
- 3.9.2 Preliminary Planning Advice for a Significant Tree was sought and a Development Application is not likely to be supported.
- 3.9.3 The tree is in good health and doesn't achieve removal through the current criteria framework



**3.10 10 Morgan Street, Parafield Gardens (significant tree)**

- 3.8.1 The Euc leucoxylon tree is noted as significant under the amended PDI Act in May 2024 and has been inspected by two independent arborists.
- 3.8.2 Preliminary Planning Advice for a Significant Tree was sought and a Development Application is not likely to be supported.
- 3.8.3 The tree is in good health and doesn't achieve removal through the current criteria framework.





#### 4. FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

- 4.1 The approximate cost for the removal of trees is detailed in the below table

- 4.2 All costs are inclusive of the development approval fee, tree removal cost, traffic management and stump grinding.

#### 5. CONCLUSION

- 5.1 In accordance with the approved tree removal procedure, some decisions relating to the retention of trees have been appealed.
- 5.2 Site meetings have been completed and the Environmental Sustainability and Trees Sub Committee can now consider and decide to approve removal, refuse removal or recommend that a Development Application be lodged for removal in line with the Sub Committee's adopted Terms of Reference.

<b>SUMMARY</b>	Council considered a report on Sustainability Partnership opportunities that could support implementation of the <i>Sustainability Strategy 2035</i> in December 2023. Council approved pursuing a trial of a Regional Climate Partnership with the City of Playford, Town of Gawler, Local Government Association and Department for Environment and Water, with a further report to be presented to Council with a Memorandum of Understanding. In 2024 discussions were held between the parties in relation to regional collaboration on climate action and this report provides an update on this progress.

**RECOMMENDATION**That Council:

1. Notes this report.

**1. BACKGROUND**

- 1.1 Regional Climate Partnerships have been active across the southern, eastern and western regions of metropolitan Adelaide for over 10 years. These partnerships have made considerable progress on collaborative climate action projects and have attracted State Government and Australian Government funding for key initiatives.
- 1.2 The Cities of Playford and Salisbury collaborated on the Adapting Northern Adelaide Regional Climate Partnership for 3 years until 2018. The initiative was supported by State and Australian Government funding and included development of a Climate Change Adaptation Plan for the Northern Adelaide Region.

1.3 The opportunity and value of re-establishing a Regional Climate Partnership for the northern Adelaide region with the City of Playford, Town of Gawler, Local Government Association (LGA) and Department for Environment and Water was identified in 2023 following endorsement of the *Sustainability Strategy 2035*.

1.4 Council resolved at its meeting held on 18 December 2023 that it:

*“Approves pursuing establishment of a trial Regional Climate Partnership with the City of Playford, Town of Gawler, Local Government Association and Department for Environment and Water with a further report to be presented to Council with a Memorandum of Understanding.”*

*Resolution 0562/2023*

## **2. EXTERNAL CONSULTATION / COMMUNICATION**

2.1 Meetings have been held with representatives from the City of Playford, Town of Gawler, Department for Environment and Water, Green Adelaide, the Climate Partnerships Coordination Team (who are hosted at the Local Government Association) and Northern Adelaide Waste Management Authority.

## **3. DISCUSSION**

3.1 Since December 2023, discussions have been ongoing with representatives from all parties to address action on climate change. These meetings have involved sharing knowledge and progress updates on climate change action, discussing challenges and opportunities related to climate change and discussing potential governance options for a more formal partnership.

3.2 It has been suggested that a formal partnership, such as through a Memorandum of Understanding, would not be pursued in the short term as each council is at a different stage and has a different approach to addressing climate change.

3.3 All parties recognise the benefits of climate change action and the potential for future project specific collaboration where councils' work programs and priorities align. If additional funding is needed, collaborative approaches are more likely to attract external grant funding.

3.4 Each council has identified current and planned emissions reduction and climate adaptation work to facilitate discussion on areas of joint interest and collaboration opportunities.

3.5 Areas of joint interest that have been discussed include:

- use and analysis of tree canopy and urban heat mapping data;
- application of biodiversity sensitive urban design;
- climate risk assessment;
- climate adaptation for assets and infrastructure; and
- climate resilient housing and development.

3.6 The benefits of joint consultation include:

- sharing of learnings, issues and case examples of climate action to inform future work;
  - providing a sounding board for climate related work;
  - sharing of knowledge and capacity building;
  - enhancement of engagement with the Climate Partnerships Coordination Team hosted by LGA, Climate Change Team in the Department for Environment and Water and Green Adelaide;
  - inclusion in the Regional Climate Partnerships (RCPs) network of councils and receipt of updates on State Government projects, learnings from other RCPs and advice on new resources and funding opportunities; and
  - progress on building of a stronger case to seek funding through collaboration in the future.
- 3.7 Recent discussions have identified that each council has identified climate change knowledge and capability gaps within their organisations and discussed the opportunity to collaborate on development of training materials and programs.
- 3.8 Where it is cost effective and timely, project-based collaboration opportunities, such as climate change related training programs, would be pursued through existing budgets or the usual budget bid processes as applicable.

#### **4. FINANCIAL OVERVIEW**

- 4.1 There are no financial implications of this report.
- 4.2 If a project collaboration is proposed which requires funding, it will be sought from within existing operational budgets or through the usual budget bid processes as applicable.

#### **5. CONCLUSION**

- 5.1 Since December 2023, discussions have been ongoing with representatives from all parties to address action on climate change.
- 5.2 It has been agreed that a formal partnership would not be pursued in the short term as each council is at a different stage and has a different approach to addressing climate change.
- 5.3 The benefits of continuing consultation on climate change action are recognised by all parties.
- 5.4 It is noted there may be opportunities for project specific collaboration where councils' work programs and priorities align and collaboration is viewed favourably by funding bodies.
- 5.5 Where it is cost effective and timely, project-based collaboration opportunities will be pursued through existing budgets, or the usual budget bid processes as applicable.
- 5.6 An update on the Regional Climate Partnership for northern Adelaide will be provided to Council in February 2026.
